The Global Reading Network is governed by an interagency, inter-organizational Steering Committee made up of members committed to the mission of the Network

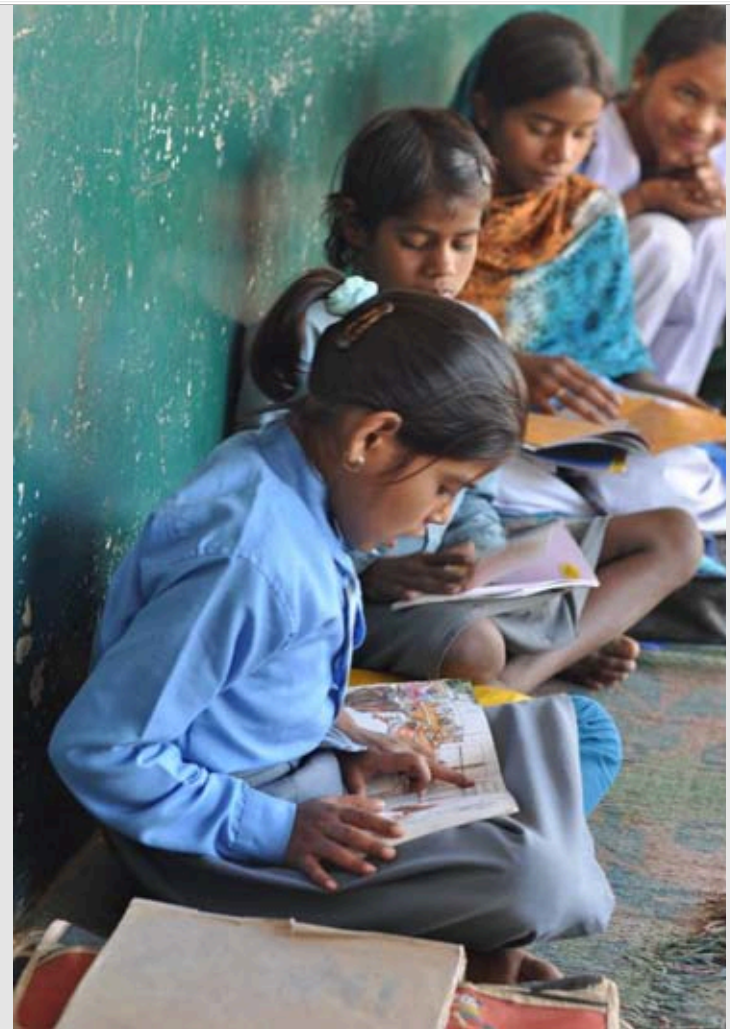


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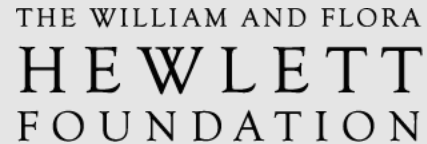
The Reading within Reach project (REACH) serves as Secretariat for the Global Reading Network.
