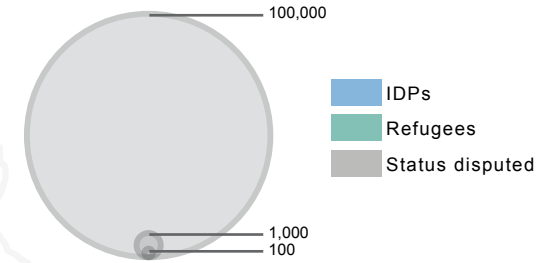


DISPLACED POPULATION
