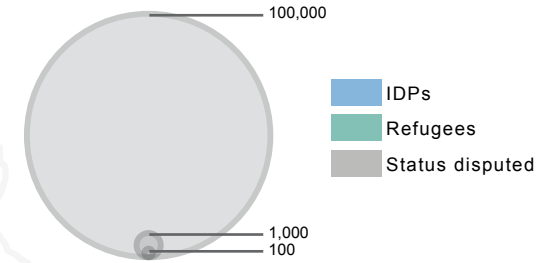


DISPLACED POPULATION
